GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This is an executive position responsible for the planning, administration, and nurturing of student services and activities compatible with the values and mission of the university. Areas of responsibilities for the Vice President include Recreational Sports, Residence Life, the Setzer Student Center, University Health Center, Dining/Vending Services, Book Store, Divisional Operations, Orientation Programs, Student Judicial/Rights and Responsibilities, Student Affairs Programs, Student Activities, and Student Organizations/Greek Life. The Vice President is the Chief Student Affairs Officer and works under minimal supervision, with extensive latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment. This is a security-sensitive position. The Vice President reports to the University President and serves on the Executive Council.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- 1. Develops and recommends policy and procedures to the President.
- 2. Ensures compliance with Texas State University System *Rules and Regulations*, as well as Lamar University and divisional policies and procedures.
- 3. Implements long-range strategic planning and assessment for divisional units.
- 4. Evaluates processes and personnel relevant to the efficient and effective execution of divisional responsibilities.
- 5. Assesses the effectiveness of divisional programs and services, makes modifications when necessary and/or implements new programs and services when needed.
- 6. Evaluates the adequacy of and successfully manages annual budgets.
- 7. Represents the division within the University community on various councils and committees.
- 8. Represents the University to a variety of civic, professional, and governmental agencies.
- 9. Develops, supervises, and initiates projects, programs, and/or assignments in collaboration with the other Executives and submits them for approval to the President.
- 10. Performs other related duties as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

A. REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

The successful candidate must possess the following knowledge, skills, and abilities or, using some other form of skills and abilities, be able to explain and demonstrate that he or she can perform the essential functions of the job, with or without reasonable accommodation.

- 1. Proven and substantive record of successful management and staff leadership experience, preferably in higher education student affairs or services.
- 2. Strong organizational, interpersonal, writing and speaking skills and the ability to communicate effectively within a university environment.
- 3. Comprehensive and current knowledge of "best practices" in student affairs.

B. EDUCATION

The successful candidate must have an earned doctoral (or other terminal) degree from an accredited institution in a related field. An academic emphasis in student administration, higher education, counseling, or closely related field is preferred.

C. EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

Eight or more years of progressively responsible and relevant experience is required for the successful candidate. Management and staff leadership experience, with documented results, is also required. Experience working with university students is required and experience at a senior Doctoral Research University or equivalent is preferred.
